The Trust's governing document says the Trust is...

- (1) To provide, or assist in the provision of facilities for recreational and other leisure time activity in the interests of social welfare, with the object of improving the conditions of life of people who live, work or study in the area of benefit, including those who have special need of such facilities by reason of their youth, disability, or social or economic circumstances.

What have we achieved so far

We have developed a cricket square and Pavilion with a resident cricket club, a junior football field with 4 pitches and a clubhouse

We have developed 3 buildings - the Old Naafi (now offices and a nursery), the Officers' Mess (serviced offices and meeting rooms) and the ARC - an arts and recreation centre with soft play facility for children, a cafe, a performance studio and an art room.

We set up Skaterham and moved it to the Chapel when the ARC was due to be developed
